Food dept moves to provide healthy food to Delhiites

This Sunday onwards Delhi food safety department will undertake a massive drive to train street food vendors about basic hygiene practices. Under phase I of the project, 20,000 vendors would be trained in a month.

"Apart from hygiene, the vendors will also be trained in entrepreneurial skills in collaboration with the skill development ministry," said Dr Mrinalini Darswal, Delhi food safety commissioner.

After the 4-hour training and an assessment, the vendors will also be given a certificate. "The certificate will assure customers that the food has been prepared in a hygienic manner. If that is not the case, the customers can report the vendor on an app which will also be launched soon," said Dr Darswal....
